

SAMPLE Wedding day TIMELINE



BRIDE GETTING READY - 60 Mins.

I always find that photographing a Bride or Groom getting ready for the wedding day, really ties in your entire story. I plan to arrive at your getting ready location about 60 Minutes before you plan to leave to your ceremony, to photograph those little details!

GROOM GETTING READY - 45 Mins.

As there isn't as much to photograph with the gentlemen, I usually suggest that the other photographer arrive at the men getting ready about 45 minutes prior to leaving for the ceremony! This is a great time to give him a letter or any gifts to have him open in private!



FIRST LOOK - 30 Mins.

If you choose to do a first look at your wedding, this is an intimate moment that I normally suggest to just have your photographer and yourselves. I normally suggest 30 minutes for this part of the day in order to arranging the meeting and capturing those initial first look moments.

FAMILY PHOTOS - 30 Mins.

I typically suggest that formal family photos are done immediately after the ceremony, this way you haven't lost them to the bar or conversation! ALWAYS tell your family ahead of time that they are going to be in photos after the ceremony, and limit it to immediate family.





WEDDING PARTY PHOTOS - 30-45 Mins.

Once family photos are complete we can now move to the desired location to start your formal photos! We start with lots of fun group shots then break it down to guys & girls! I also love to photograph each bridesmaid with the bride and vice versa for the gentlemen!

BRIDE & GROOM PHOTOS - 45 -60 Mins

After we send your wedding party away, it is time to relax, take a drink and cuddle up with your new spouse! Taking our time to explore the location and get as much variety as possible will make your gallery feel full! It is also a great time to get some one on one with each other!



RECEPTION - 3-4 Hours

Depending on the package you book for your big day, the amount of time at a reception will vary. I always recommend to finalize your photography timeline ASAP so you can plan your reception and make sure the things you want photographed happen before I leave.

SUNSET PHOTOS - 20-30 Mins.

If the weather grants us a sunset on your wedding day, I always recommend planning about 20-30 minutes in your reception to sneak away so we can take just a few more photos of just you two! This will add variety to your images and who doesn't love a gorgeous sunset!!
